Please note - if you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate, you must either include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code if you wish to receive relief. Currently 40% income tax payers can receive 25p back for every £1 of amounts gift aided to charities and can carry back donations made before the filing of their tax return to the prior year. Please note, we understand this does not apply to anonymous cash gifts where there is some limited ability for charities to claim gift aid on small cash donations.
